## July 19, 2020

### Gathering

- Liturgist: O Lord, where can I go from your Spirit?  
Where can I flee from your presence?
- Liturgist: If I go up to the heavens; you are there.  
If I make my bed in the depths; you are there.  
If I rise on the wings of the dawn or settle on the far side of the sea,  
even there your hand will guide me, your right hand will hold me fast.
- Liturgist: If I say, "Surely darkness will hide me and the light will become night  
around me," even the darkness will not be dark to you; the night will  
shine like the day, for the darkness is as light to you.
- Liturgist: For you created my inmost being; you knit me together in my mother's  
womb. I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your  
works are wonderful, I know that full well. *Psalms 139: 8-14*
- Singing: 378 "Lord of All Hopefulness"
- Lord of all hopefulness, Lord of all joy,  
whose trust, ever child-like, no cares could destroy:  
be there at our waking, and give us, we pray,  
your bliss in our hearts, Lord, at the break of the day.
- Lord of all eagerness, Lord of all faith,  
whose strong hands were skilled at the plane and the lathe:  
be there at our labors, and give us, we pray,  
your strength in our hearts, Lord, at the noon of the day.
- Lord of all kindness, Lord of all grace,  
your hands swift to welcome, your arms to embrace:  
be there at our homing, and give us we pray,  
your love in our hearts, Lord, at the eve of the day.
- Lord of all gentleness, Lord of all calm,  
whose voice is contentment, whose presence is balm:  
be there at our sleeping, and give us, we pray,  
your peace in our hearts, Lord, at the end of the day.
- Minister: Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ,  
through the power of the Holy Spirit. Amen. *Philippians 1: 2 adapted*

### Reconciliation

- Liturgist: There is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus, because  
through Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit who gives life has set you free  
from the law of sin and death.

Liturgist: For what the law was powerless to do because it was weakened by the sinful nature, God did by sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful humanity.

Liturgist: For we know that the whole creation has been groaning as in the pains of childbirth right up to the present time. Not only so, but we ourselves, who have the first fruits of the Spirit, groan inwardly as we wait eagerly our adoption, the redemption of our bodies.

Liturgist: For in this hope we were saved.

Liturgist: But hope that is seen is no hope at all. Who hopes for what they already have? But we hope for what we do not yet have; we wait for it patiently.
