Acolyte: Jesus Christ is the light of the world. We light this candle as a sign that Christ has

come and Christ will come again. As the light pushes back darkness let us walk with,

learn from, and worship Jesus Christ.

* CALL TO WORSHIP

Liturgist: The Lord is my light and my salvation – whom shall I fear?

All: The Lord is the stronghold of my life – of whom shall I be afraid?

Liturgist: One thing I ask of from the Lord, this only do I seek: that I may dwell in the house

of the Lord all the days of my life, to gaze on the beauty of the Lord and seek him

in his temple.

All: For in the day of trouble he will keep me safe in his dwelling; he will hide me in

the shelter of his tabernacle and set me high upon a rock.

has come near." Matthew 4:12-17
