carry it out. For I do not do the good I want to do, but the evil that I don't want to

do - this I keep on doing.

All: Now if I do what I do not want to do, it is no longer I who do it, but it is sin living

in me that does it.

Liturgist: So I find this law at work: Although I want to do good, evil is right there with me.

For in my inner being I delight in God's law; but I see another law at work in me, waging war against the law of my mind and making me a prisoner of the law of

sin within me. Romans 7:15, 18-23

Silent Confession and Reflection

Liturgist: Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus,
