Acolyte: Jesus Christ is the light of the world. We light this candle as a sign that Christ has come and Christ will come again. As the light pushes back darkness let us walk with, learn from, and worship Jesus Christ.

All: Praise the Lord from the earth.

Reconciliation

Liturgist: I will greatly rejoice in the Lord, my whole being shall exult in my God; for he has clothed me with the garments of salvation, he has covered me with the robe of righteousness, as a bridegroom decks himself with a garland, and as a bride adorns herself with her jewels.

All: **For as the earth brings forth its shoots, and as a garden causes what is sown in it to spring up, so the Lord God will cause righteousness and praise to spring up before all the nations.** *Isaiah 61:10-11*

Liturgist: In that confidence we confess our sin and brokenness.

Silent Confession and Reflection

Liturgist: But when the fullness of time had come, God sent his Son, born of a woman, born under the law, in order to redeem those who were under the law, so that we might receive adoption as children.

All: **And because we are children, God has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, crying, “Abba! Father!”**
