Gathering

WELCOME & LIGHTING THE CHRIST CANDLE

Acolyte: Jesus Christ is the light of the world. We light this candle as a sign that Christ has come and Christ will come again. As the light pushes back darkness let us walk with, learn from, and worship Jesus Christ.

* CALL TO WORSHIP

Liturgist: The mighty one, God the Lord, speaks and summons the earth from the rising of the sun to its setting. Out of Zion, the perfection of beauty, God shines forth.

All: Our God comes and does not keep silent; before him is a devouring fire and a mighty tempest all around him.

Liturgist: He calls to the heavens above and to the earth, that he may judge his people: "Gather to me my faithful ones, who made a covenant with me by sacrifice!"

All: The heavens declare his righteousness, for God himself is judge.

Liturgist: O Lord our God, you answered them, you were to Israel a forgiving God, though you punished their misdeeds.

All: Exalt the Lord our God and worship at his holy mountain, for the Lord our God is holy.

Silent Confession and Reflection

Liturgist: Even as we gather in your name, acknowledge your holiness, and proclaim your mercy, we long for you. Hear us as we pray:

All: God of love, in the wrong we have done and the good we have left undone, we have sinned in weakness, in ignorance, and through our own deliberate fault. Forgive us and renew our lives through Jesus Christ, our Lord.

Liturgist: If the ministry that brought condemnation was glorious, how much more the glorious is the ministry that brings righteousness!

All: If what was transitory came with glory, how much greater is the glory of that which lasts!

Liturgist: For whenever anyone turns to the Lord, the veil is taken away. Now the Lord is the Spirit and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom.

People: And we, who with unveiled faces all reflect the Lord's glory, are being transformed into his likeness with ever-increasing glory, which comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit.
