Silent Confession and Reflection

Liturgist: Therefore, God exalted him even more highly and gave him the name that is

above every other name, so that at the name given to Jesus every knee should bend, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue

should confess

All: that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
