Silent Confession and Reflection

- Liturgist: Know that the Lord has set apart his faithful servant for himself; the Lord hears when I call to him. Tremble and do not sin; when you are on your beds, search your hearts and be silent. Offer the sacrifices of the righteous and trust in the Lord.
- All Many, Lord, are asking, "Who will bring us prosperity?" Let the light of your face shine on us. Fill my heart with joy when their grain and new wine abound.
- Liturgist: In peace I will lie down and sleep, for you alone, Lord, make me dwell in safety. Psalm 4
- All Singing: 666 "I Will Give You Rest" Repeating, following leader
- Liturgist: See what great love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God!
- All: And that is what we are!
- Liturgist: The reason the world does not know us is that it did not know him. Dear friends, now we are children of God, and what we will be has not yet been made known.
- All: But we know that when Christ appears, we shall be like him, for we shall see him as he is.
- Liturgist: All who have this hope in him purify themselves, just as he is pure. Everyone who sins breaks the law; in fact, sin is lawlessness.
- All: But you know that he appeared so that he might take away our sins. And in him is no sin.
- Liturgist: Dear children, do not let anyone lead you astray. The one who does what is right is righteous, just as he is righteous.
